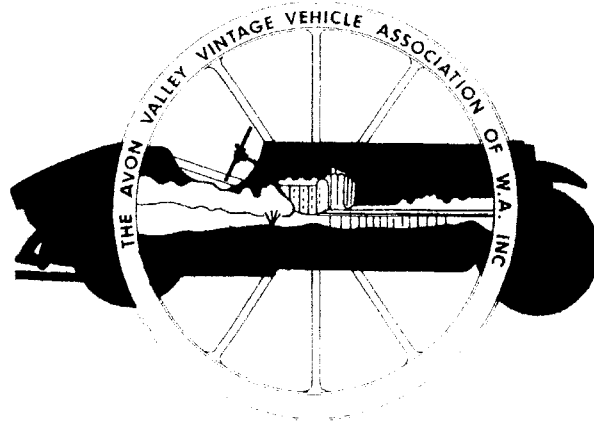

Our Christmas Party will be a BYO everything affair at Bert & Angie Hayes farm at Grass Valley. Camping overnight is available if you

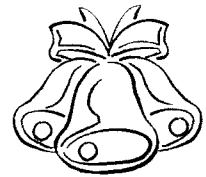

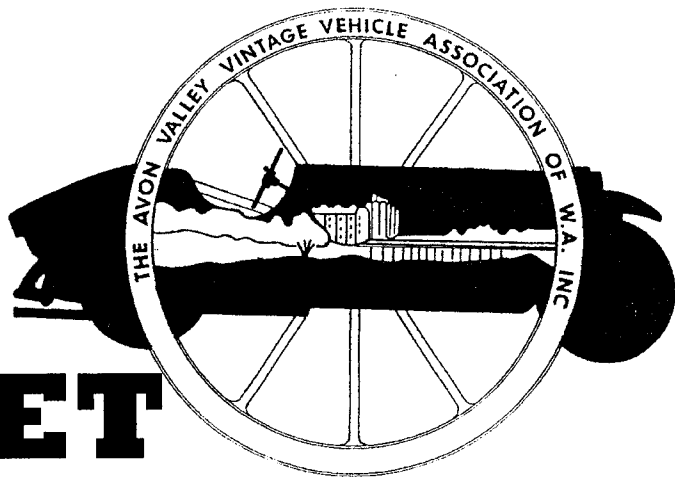
