CONCESSIONAL LICENCE

Inspection of all concessionally licenced vehicles will be held one month earlier next year as I will be away in July, the normal time the DPI require the reports to be submitted. Inspections at Northam and Gidgegannup will be in March and April. Other areas, by arrangement with the scrutineer. If you are going to be away in March and April or intend to be too sick or too busy working, contact your scrutineer and get it done earlier.

It is YOUR responsibility to have your vehicles inspected. Not my job to chase you up. If the DPI put your vehicle on full license don't blame me and I won't be here to sort it out. You could also be up for stamp duty and a DPI inspection when it goes to full.

If you have a vehicle nearing completion and you intend to get it on to concessional license during July / August please get your letter from me before then. You will need to pay '08/'09 fees early.

BUYING A CAR ?:

If you buy a vehicle on full licence, and intend to have it on concession, DO NOT put the transfer papers in until you have the concession papers ready to go with them or else you will pay stamp duty! You have 14 days from purchase to do the transfer.

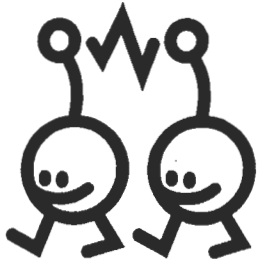

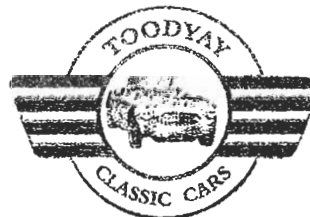
