General Business:

***Financial Matters:** Concern was expressed with sensitive information or statistics being listed in the Minutes and therefore in the newsletter.

*Moved: Fred Singleton... Seconded: Malcolm Strahan... Future financial reports to show only day to day managing of Club affairs. Any other information needed or warranted by Members to be requested through the Treasurer.
Accepted and carried*

***CMC Calendar:** Fred reported that due to leave/absence of CMC Editor, our Swapmeet has only recently been listed in their Calendar.

***Bethavon visit:** They would like the Club to take 5 or 6 vintage vehicles to Bethavon one morning, as in previous years. Arrange for this visit in March or April. A vintage jeep will be appropriate, especially with the Anzac celebrations.

***1927 Auburn Roadster: Model 8-77,** with wooden spoke wheels. The present owners are seeking more info on this vehicle, ie Doctors name, original plate number, registration details, copy of any old photos. What is known is that the vehicle was purchased new by a Doctor in Northam, who owned it during the 1930's to possibly up to the mid/late 1940's. It was then traded in on a new Holden.

Possible avenues could be through the RAC, VCC, Whiteman Park Car Museum. Can be followed up when possible

***Lease:** No further update, still pursuing the official document whereabouts. The land wanting to be leased by the NHF is Brookfield land, and information from the Shire is that they will be contacting our Club re our access at the back to our Shed, and from the shed to our Clubrooms.

***Building:** The ceiling has been repaired in the memorabilia room, further painting and finishing of the verandah Completed.

***What else can be done?:** discussion re status – We have already moved into our lease period and have on hand improvements we wish to make to our Clubrooms. These cannot be considered until the lease is official from the Government and the terms clarified. Only then can we move ahead to make the Clubrooms more user friendly and be utilised as it should be.

***Meetings:** The consensus of this meeting is that AVVVA Club Meetings will work on Saturdays, thus enabling Members to travel from a distance and avoid late night travelling.

Moved: Barry Bristow-Stagg... Seconded: Frank Lewis... That our monthly meetings be held on the third Saturday of the month at 10.30am at the Clubrooms, and to include a busy bee if and when required. Further that meetings will be re-organised as and when necessary if on the same day as a scheduled Event. Carried

***Gum tree:** At certain times the weather allows leaves & debris to be blown onto premises opposite. It was pointed out that the tree in question is on the old Signal Platform area, and should be reported directly to the Shire.

***Swapmeet:** Showers to be organised for Members on Security. AvonWaste be advised 2 skip bins only.

Bays may be 4m x 10m, to be checked with vehicle/trailer. Oval painting to be done first at 9am. Purchase of 2 paint applicator markers, & 12 cans of paint.

Safety Issue: Oval lights need to be on for half to one hour from 5am Sunday morn. Last year at this time the lack of clear light was a safety issue.

***Old Stove:** The Moora Historical Society are starting a Museum, and if the old stove in the kitchen was surplus to requirements it could have a good home in Moora.

Moved: Fred Singleton.,. Seconded: Theo Bekkers... That Kaye Lewis take the stove and place it in its new home with the Moora Historical Society Museum. Carried
