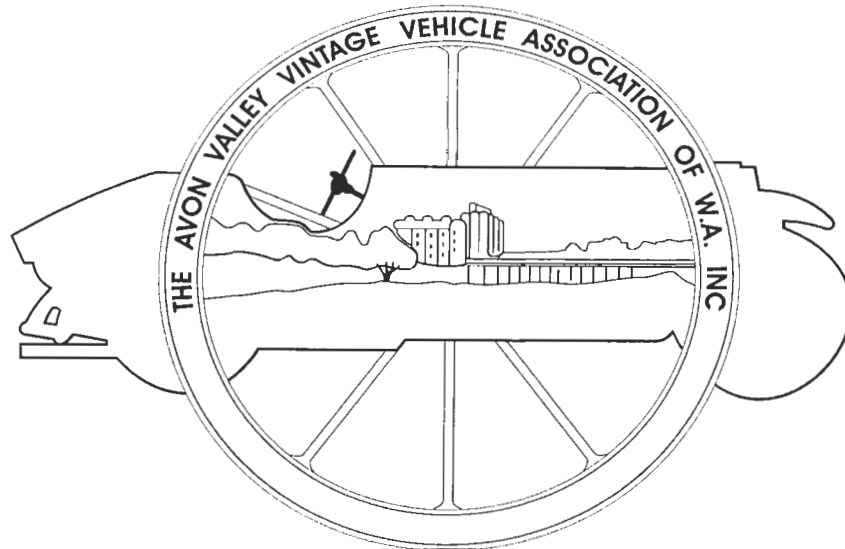

GENERAL BUSINESS:

1. Ray Howell has swapped his T Model Ford with Theo Bekkers for another T Model Ford.
2. Jeff Mills commented many concessional vehicles do not travel any distance between annual inspection days. The secretary commented we always ask members to use their vehicles on club runs but that is up to

the individual. Any run held by any CMC member club is OK to attend. (Note: For concessional licensed vehicles, overuse ie. **use as an everyday car** is of great concern to all clubs in WA and is not tolerated.)

3. Leanne Lee to change the wording on the annual accounts to have: Avon Valley Vintage Vehicle Association of WA Inc.
4. The Busy Bee days are to stay the same. It is up to the shed committee to set the jobs for the members.
5. Leanne Lee needs a steering box for a 1936 Ford.
6. The AIS Inspections (new to concessional licence) should be booked by phone with the AIS inspector **and not done** on the Annual inspection days.
7. The total vehicles inspected at the AVVVA shed were 11 in April and 12 in May.
8. The 2007 Rally West now will allow **pre 1940** vehicles on the 12th – 21st October 2007 Rally.

CONCESSIONAL VEHICLE OWNERS

If you have a vehicle on concessional license it should have been inspected and have RED inspection sticker, expiry 2008, on it. If your vehicle is under repair you should have, by now, sent me a letter with the odometer reading and acknowledging that the vehicle will not be driven until it has been inspected and the sticker attached. If neither of these has been done then it won't be on my list to the DPI and they will put it on full rates. There will also be a fine of \$25 by the AVVVA if we have to deal with the DPI about your vehicle ie to get it to stay on concession.

If you are not using the vehicle you can de-license it and, on request, the DPI will hold your plates for re-issue to you at a later date.

June 30 is the cut off date to be included in the list to the DPI.

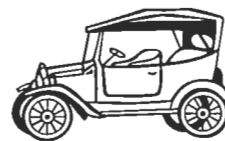

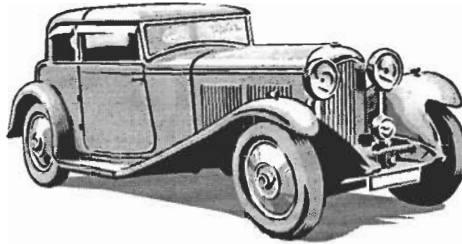

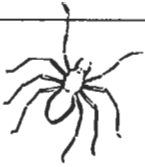
