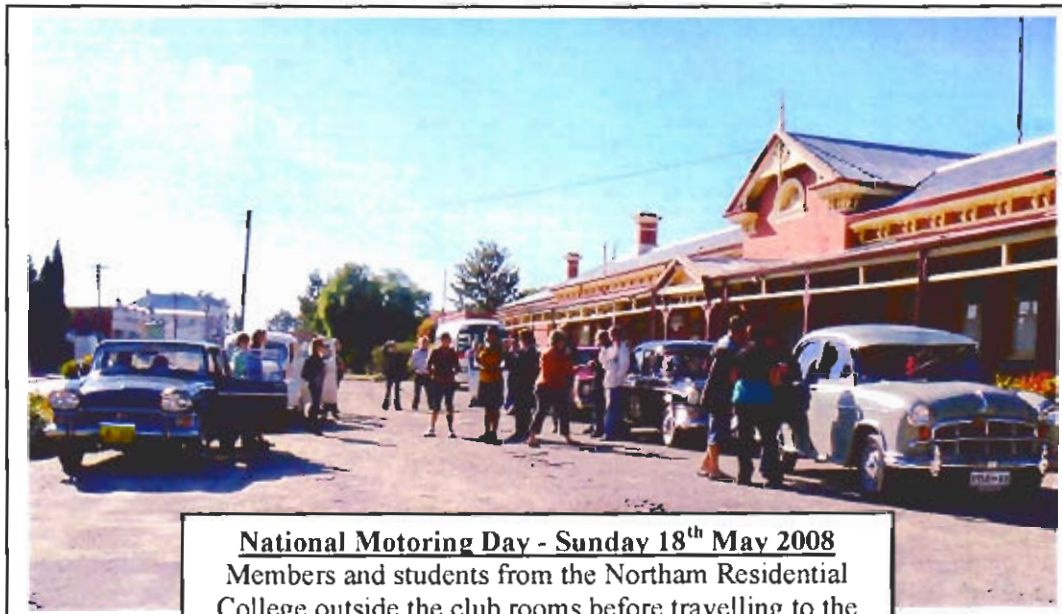

# Toodyay Lions and Toodyay Classic Cars Fund Raising Event



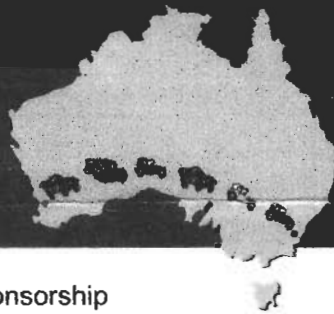
## 'T Cup Run'

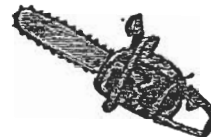

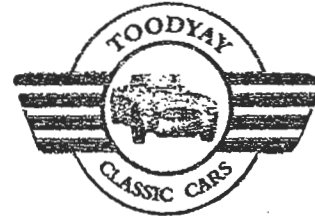
