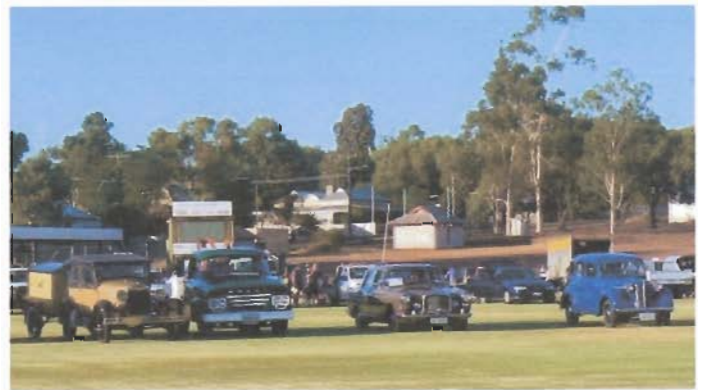

A Serious Issue

I am interrupting the Model T pages for a more serious problem. The parking area for members cars. Our clubrooms are on a main street, Fitzgerald Street. For years we used parking in front of the old Railway station. It was convenient and off-street. However this came to an abrupt end when the Shire of Northam decided to convert the Station to a sort of museum. The area in front was ploughed up and reshaped with paved paths, gardens, and beautified with large rocks. This removed quite a large parking area which was in character with the Station use and we were relegated to kerbside parking.

An AVVVA member had a look at the situation and made a suggested ground plan which also solved another problem for us. This plan was presented at the meeting on 21/1/2010. Members made little comment but seemed to be in general agreement. A delegate was appointed to present the plan to the Shire of Northam.

Besides the parking there is also the issue of the entrance to our inspection and automotive workshop. Our vintage cars are required to be inspected annually and easy access is required to get to the inspection area. What happens currently is as follows. A member turns up at the clubrooms for vehicle inspection. Sorry, wrong place. They are directed to go back up Fitzgerald Street to the first right turn, then again right, right again into a small street with no name. Go 50 metres down there till you get to a steel fence, turn right again onto a dirt track. They are then confronted by a large shed. Oops, gone too far. Back up to an unmarked gate on their right. This must be it! Go through the gate, over a rail line, sharp left. Ah they are now in a lane to the inspection bay, cars in front, cars pulling up behind, locked in. Lane so narrow it is difficult to get out of the vehicle, rails in a pile on one side, a wire fence with debris and junk stacked against it on the other. It's safer to stay in the vehicle. They are stuck in their vehicle waiting their turn to get inspected.

Our plan is an entrance from Fitzgerald Street and removing the rail wagons, rails and debris to make an empty lot suitable for parking and secure from the road. This will also do away with the back entrance requirement.

The next day our diplomat presented the plan to the Shire, dismissal was instant. We cannot have the driveway, the rail wagons have to stay as dilapidated and ugly as you have to see to believe. If a private organisation had this yard anywhere in Northam, the Shire would issue a clean-up order. This rubbish is an eyesore and long beyond repair or restoration.

When they eventually open the museum they will require staff which they hope to be non-paid volunteers, they are looking at recruiting AVVVA members. I doubt any are interested as they will be held responsible for looking after the safety of visitors. Children will slip away and find the junk and wagons in the rear yard. No doubt some children will try to climb on the wagons and the rotten steps will no doubt cause some child an injury. I believe our members should refuse to take this on without the removal of the wagons and a clean-up of the yard to make the area safe for visitors and their children. If this area is cleaned up it would make an ideal off-street parking are for the museum as well as for the AVVVA members.

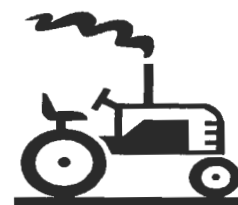

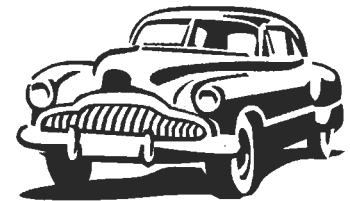

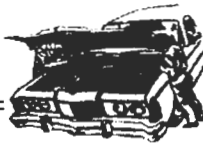
